Dr. Shawn visits the White House

Willingway congratulates Medical Director Dr. Shawn Williams on a recent contribution to our physician training program. The American Board of Addiction Medicine (ABAM) has approved his application to recognize Willingway as a certified facility to host Addiction Medicine Fellowships.
