Our 50 years of unwavering dedication and experience will empower you with the tools and skills essential for the uplifting journey toward addiction recovery. A few things to remember during your admission process. Our address is 311 Jones Mill Rd., Statesboro, GA 30458. If you are entering from Veterans Memorial Hwy, you will go to the 2nd entrance on your right after the pond. If you are entering from Coach Lee Hill Blvd, you will use the first entrance on your left before the pond. Keep left once you get to the building. There is a covered entrance with two double doors; this is where you will ring the doorbell and be greeted by our committed staff. Once you walk through the doors, you will begin the admissions process. Please remember that sometimes there may be multiple admissions taking place at one time. We will do our very best to keep your wait short as we know how important this time is for you.





Once admitted, you will be assigned a counselor. A family member, agreed upon by client and counselor, will be contacted within 72 hours of admission. Your counselor will set up a time that works for the family member to provide them with weekly updates. Family sessions will take place during the last week of treatment.

Packing List

1. Clothing for 1 week. We suggest 7 to 10 outfits. We have a laundry service that will do the laundry once a week. We do not provide dry cleaning or ironing services. See below for appropriate clothing. All clients have climate-controlled private rooms.
2. Toiletry items, new and unopened containers with enough product to last throughout treatment. Yes, our clients can have razors.
3. Bathing suit and sandals or flip-flops. We have an indoor pool for use every other day.
4. Tobacco products to last throughout treatment. Cigarettes and tobacco chew ONLY. No vapes.
5. A picture ID.
6. A prepaid credit/gift card for a minimum of \$200. If you are a smoker, we recommend a \$350 card. Clients who do not have a prepaid card will NOT be able to make any purchases, including tobacco products, stamps to write letters, or any items from our in-house store. Note: If you bring a credit or debit card, you can purchase a prepaid gift card for \$200 at our facility.
7. All medications.
8. Your insurance card(s). For cases in which we are pursuing insurance, there is no guarantee of certification or approval from your insurance company. We will pursue approval; we even go through the 'appeals process' to exhaust all means to try to get them to approve your stay. More and more we are seeing plans that approve at the "Partial" level. If this happens for you, you will be responsible for lodging fees at \$150 per day. In essence, this means that your insurance company is denying inpatient treatment, and WW is working with you by accepting "Partial" (which is really an outpatient level of care) + \$150 per day for your overnight stay. This is sometimes termed "Partial with Room and Board". Note: Under this arrangement, Cigna and United Healthcare REQUIRE their clients to be housed off site.





Facility Rules

1. Do not bring outside food. We serve 3 hearty meals each day, and each unit is stocked with snack items.
2. Do not bring blankets or pillows. We provide all bedding.
3. Do not bring weapons or firearms onto property.
4. Clients will have no phone calls or visitors while in treatment. Family sessions are done during the last week of treatment.
5. Families, please call 1-912-764-6236 option 2 then 3 to get updates on your loved one. We can only speak with persons on the patient's contact list.
6. Do not drive yourself to Willingway. We do not have parking at WW for client vehicles.
7. In order to achieve successful sobriety, it is essential you remain in treatment for the length of stay agreed upon at the time of admission. If you decide to leave early and the medical staff determines that is not safe for you to discharge or it is "against staff advice," **you will be charged a \$500 administrative fee.**

Appropriate Clothing

- Slacks or neat jeans
- Bermuda shorts or walking shorts of reasonable length
- Shirts must be worn at all times (t-shirts or button-ups; please be modest)
- Appropriate undergarments, including bras, MUST be worn
- Shoes must be worn at all times outside the patient rooms
- ID bracelets or name tags required
- Women's swimsuits must be one-piece style (tankinis are acceptable if appropriate)
- Men's suits should be the traditional "swim trunks"
- Swimsuits should be covered when traveling to and from the pool or outside

Inappropriate Clothing

- Leggings, unless worn with a long top
- Short shorts, stretch-type exercise shorts, or cutoffs
- Cutoff t-shirts, tank tops, halter, bare midriff (torso) or see-through tops
- Mini skirts or mini dresses
- Clothing alluding to alcohol, drugs, and sex (these are not conducive to recovery)
- Tightly fitted clothing
- Sunglasses worn indoors

Levels of Care

Detoxification

- 24/7 Medical staff with addictionologist on-site
- Methadone Detox (upwards of 400 mg)
- Individual and family therapy

Residential and Partial Hospitalization Program

- 4 to 6 weeks of residential treatment (short-term program available)
- Private rooms and bathrooms
- Individual and group therapy
- Individualized treatment planning

Outpatient Treatment

- Intensive Outpatient Program with 9+ hours of clinical programming
- Relapse education through group and individual therapy
- Education in interpersonal relationships, coping mechanisms, and relaxation skills
- Local housing option through our extended care program if needed

Extended Treatment

- Six-month commitment (up to 18 months)
- Life skills, job training, and collegiate program and support available
- 12-Step community recovery program
- Separate male and female housing
